Enforcive releases Enforcive/Enterprise Security version 8 including all-new Compliance Assessment and IFS Auditing

(Hackensack, New Jersey and Herzliyah, Israel- November 18, 2013) Enforcive, a leading provider of security software for IBM i announced the release of Enforcive/Enterprise Security version 8. The new release covers graphical Compliance Assessments, IFS file change monitoring and tools to accelerate implementation and roll out over multiple partitions

New Features:

Graphical Compliance Assessment:

Many organizations are using Enforcive Policy Compliance Manager to check if their existing configurations are in line with their company policies and external regulations. The Policy Compliance manager gives an organization very granular tools to capture organizational policies for a large variety of event categories incl. user profiles, objects, system values, IFS, authorization lists, object integrity, etc. Basically any parameters i/OS offers for such categories can be used to define organizational policies in templates and to check the compliance of the organization's i/OS settings.

With the new Compliance Assessment, Enforcive adds a graphical layer to the Policy Compliance Manager. It enables an organization to display the compliance with its policies graphically. In addition the organization will be able to give weights to deviations and compliance. This gives management a visual interpretation as to the level of compliance adherence.

IFS Data Auditing:

Enforcive now enables organizations to track changes at data level to IFS files (including before and after changes or check their settings and report on them in the Report Generator. The IFS contains often a wealth of information; it is therefore important that it is properly monitored. The capability to track the IFS at data level comes in addition to the tools that secure and track transactions related to the IFS and check IFS settings integrity.

Additional Enhancements:

Data Providers - Syslog based Export:

With the release of version 8 Enforcive is able to export all of its transaction logs in syslog format. Organization that would like to include their IBM i events in to their Security Information & Event Management (SIEM) and Log Management tools will be able to receive a large variety of events from Enforcive incl. exit point events, SQL statements, QAUDJRN events, File Journal events, read record events, etc. Enforcive provides granular tools to define which events should be monitored on IBM i and also in what time frame (real-time or on a schedule) these events should be exported. capability gives an organization full control of which events should be delivered at what time to their SIEM and Log Management Solutions thus facilitating cross platform monitoring and optimizing performance for the systems involved.

Field Encryption & Masking:

In October, Enforcive released its product for Field Encryption. Through an intuitive GUI, organizations can use various encryption algorithms to encrypt fields. Role-based key management is provided with the option to store keys either on IBM i or a remote Windows server. The product also offers field masking and data scrambling functionalities. Enforcive/Field Encryption has been developed to avoid affecting the applications within the organization where it is deployed. Organizations therefore, do not have to change their applications when encrypting or decrypting data when using Enforcive Encryption. The product is fully integrated with version 8 of Enforcive/Enterprise Security.

Back-Up Encryption:

In addition to field encryption, masking and scrambling Enforcive also offers back-up encryption. The product provides encryption and saving of whole libraries as well as individual objects.. Organizations backing their data up to tape, now have an easy way to make sure the data can not be read by anyone who is not authorized in the event their tapes end up in wrong hands. The back-up encryption is designed to easily fit in to wider organization processes for backing up data.

Easy Multi-System Roll-Out:

The new release of Enforcive introduces many new functionalities which will further enhance the ease of use and implementation of the product. One of these enhancements is the possibility to propagate user management, system and report settings across one or more IBM i systems or partitions.

New Alert Types:

In this new version users of Enforcive will be able to generate alerts on SQL statements, especially those statements which have been activated interactively or are embedded in programs. In addition alerts have been added to notify users of changes in Enforcive internal operations.
